She is a quick, responsive, one-design which is being raced in ever growing fleets in the Chesapeake, New Jersey, and New England.

### **EXCITING NEWS** from the board

Dear Members,

It is with great excitement that we announce MRYC took title to Mr. Beattie's house at 403 Riverview Lane on Tuesday, April 13, 2021. The rare opportunity to acquire this adjoining parcel of land was evaluated heavily by both past and current Officers and Board of Trustees. Unanimously it was determined that its acquisition is in the best interest of the club thus preserving future expansion. The purchase of Mr. Beattie's house was an unplanned and unforeseen event and as such the Club is looking to offset interim carrying costs as we look to assemble the property in conjunction with our future master plan.

At this time, the Club is opening an invitation to lease the property for "light business/professional use" to club members ONLY in an "as-is" condition with a short-term month to month lease. Both Active and non-Active members will be considered. The house will be available to view all day on Clean Up Day or by appointment through May 1, 2021. The decision to temporarily rent the property is made with a clear eye towards our fiscal responsibility to the club. Since we were unable to budget for any repairs to the property in 2021, we felt the best course would be a short-term lease. Our goal is to help offset some of the costs we will be incurring in 2021 and give us time to explore all our options for the future. The next step will involve setting up a sub committee of Board members and interested members to explore the options available to us as we plan for the future of this property.
