- Parent must remain on premise unless child is directly supervised in a program such as swim lesson, tennis lesson or sailing program.


Children 6- 12:


- Must be accompanied to club. May visit restrooms and lower level by themselves.

- Parent must remain on premise unless child is directly supervised in a program such as swim lesson, tennis lesson or sailing program.

Children 0 - 21:

May not approach the bar to order or be seated in bar area.

Parents bringing children to events must supervise children at all times and prevent them from running or shouting while indoors. No children are allowed in the bridge room. No wet bathing suits/towels/clothes permitted upstairs.

By tailoring the equipment and the size of the playing court to the size, needs and athletic ability of young children, Pee Wee tennis allows them to learn tennis quickly and to have fun and success playing the game.

Level I- QUICKSTART. Develop stroke technique, hand eye coordination and rally skills.

10 and under balls will be used. [Ages 7 and over] Times: Monday & Wednesday 12:30 - 1:30 PM \$260.00 for 8 week session

Level II – FUTURES. Teach the fundamentals of all shots, with an introduction into point play through games. [Ages 10 and over] Times: Monday & Wednesday 1:30 - 3:30 PM \$260.00 for 8 week session

Level III - CHALLENGERS. Higher Skill Level with continued teaching of technique, but more emphasis on point play. [Ages 10 and over] Times: Monday & Wednesday 2:30 - 3:30 PM \$260.00 for 8 week session

Level IV - VARSITY -A more intense program geared towards the high school team player. Emphasis will be on improving the basic skills with an introduction to other aspects of the game such as proper strategy, concentration, and conditioning. TENNIS TOURNAMENTS

HERE'S HOW THE ADULT CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENTS WORK AT MRYC:

Signing Up

- 1. Register at MRYC.org. If you have questions, email or call Charlie Baccaro at 732-245-7471 or cb737@aol.com.
- 2. The deadline for tournament entries is Thursday, June 3rd.

The Draw

- 3. On Friday, June 4th, we hold our Tournament Draw Party at 5pm at the tennis courts.
- 4. For each tournament, previous champions and finalists are seeded one and two.
- 5. All other participants are drawn and placed on the tournament sheet.

The Play

- 6. Deadline to play each opponent is on the tournament sheet posted at the courts.
- 7. The team on top of the bracket should contact their opponent to set up their match.
- 8. Deadlines must be met. Don't wait until the last minute to schedule your match.

The Finals

- 9. Tournament Finals: Thursday, 8/19, Friday, 8/20, all day Saturday, 8/21 and Sunday, 8/22. Specific dates for each Tournament Final will be posted on the club website.
- 10. All courts are closed during the Tournament Finals.

The Fine Print

- 11. Courts for tournament matches may be reserved at any time, even during Open Tennis.
- 12. If you are not available to play your Final match from 8/19 to 8/22 you must forfeit.
- 13. If you are not available to play your tournament match by the due date, you must forfeit.
- 14. The same team cannot play in more than one tournament.
- 15. In Filial Doubles, juniors must be 14 years of age or younger during the 2021 calendar year.
- 16. For Filial only, if the match goes to a third set, a tiebreaker is played in lieu of a third set.
- 17. In Century Doubles, the combined age of the team must equal 100 or higher.

MRYC Book Club


All Are Welcome!

The MRYC Book Club meets at 7:00 pm on the second Wednesday of every month. Everyone is welcome!


